What is included

Three reference lists and 30 two-page practice sets.

Who it is for

Adults supporting a learner who is working on Fry words.

How to start

Use your teacher's group, then choose a few words that need practice.

What you need

A pencil and an adult who can model the words aloud.

Printing

Print only the current set. Use Actual size or Fit to printable area.

A note about reading

Connect letters to sounds. Explain unfamiliar spellings explicitly.

Use and sharing

For one household or one classroom. Do not resell or post the PDF.

A simple practice routine

Use a few words at a time. The sets are not a race or a grade-level test.

1. Read together

Say the word. Connect the letters to the sounds the learner knows.

Point out any unusual spelling; do not ask the learner to guess.

2. Write and say

Trace the light word once, then write it on the line.

Say a short sentence using the word.

3. Check gently

Ask the learner to read without help. Mark READ or HELP.

A check describes this attempt, not permanent mastery.

4. Revisit

Return to words marked HELP on another day.

Move to a new set when the learner is ready.

These sets are alphabetical within each published group of 100.
